A mixed-bill evening of dance ranging from classical to contemporary dance, Fall Forward features performances from The Ngoma School students. DDT presents three world premieres *Rise, The Winds of Time*, and *The Happy Hour*. Rise explores the range of emotion three men experience in the midst of uncertainty, fear, pain, and hope. Like dust, they rise. The *Winds of Time* honors and gives a homegoing to soul-singer, Aretha Franklin. *The Happy Hour* is a tutu ballet that sheds light on life's jovial moments of self-expression, play, and friend interaction.
