To have no hard edges makes one capable of constant flow. *Fluid* is an evening work inspired by physical theater, Afro-modern presented through contemporary ballet. *Fluid* is performed to the music of Ezio Bosso, Lo Cor de la Plana, Kronos Quartet, and more. Centered around a cast of strangers, nowhere but somewhere, *Fluid* examines human kindness and emotion through the life trials of trust, lost, betrayal and love.
