Ngoma Center For Dance's Shawn Short is the principal actor in Dog Bark Media's latest DocuDrama *His Eyes Saw Dance*.

Award-winning Black choreographer and visionary Shawn Short, navigates the white-dominated world of DC dance. *His Eyes Saw Dance* is a docudrama series that gives light to the behind-the-scenes of Dissonance Dance Theatre, and The Ngoma School (it's professional school) as Shawn strives to keeps professional Black dance alive as he operates the only contemporary ballet between NYC and ATL.
